

LEARN OR REVIEW ALGEBRA 2/TRIG IN ONE MONTH THIS SUMMER!

Dates: Monday through Thursday, June 21 through July 15 (4 weeks)

Class does *not* meet on Fridays (except for the week of July 4!)
(The week of July 5–10 we will meet Tuesday through Friday so that the 4th of July weekend can be extended.)

Curriculum: This course includes the complete Algebra 2 curriculum offered at Sequoia High School. Topics include complex numbers, inverse functions, exponential functions and logarithms, probability, systems of equations, quadratic functions and graphing of polynomials, radical and rational functions, sequences and series, and trigonometry.

A grade of B or better in this class will prepare students for precalculus in the fall.

Credit: This class will *not* provide actual high school units, and is not an official Sequoia High School course. However, successful completion will allow the opportunity to advance to precalculus if you go to Sequoia High School, Woodside High School, or Carmont High School. If you are attending another high school, individual arrangements must be made with your school. Advancement cannot be guaranteed for non Sequoia High School students unless these advance arrangements are made, and advancement is subject to approval by your high school. Contact Dr. Bittner prior to registering for the class if you go to another high school and advancing to precalculus is important to you.

Successful completion of the course with a B or better is required in order to advance to precalculus in the Sequoia Union High School District this fall.

Course Requirements: You should have a B+ or better in your current math class (minimum of Geometry is preferred, but Algebra 1 students are also eligible) in order to take this course. This course will cover everything you need to advance to precalculus, but it will be fast paced, so you should plan to spend some time on math for four weeks.

Cost: \$425 flat fee

Refund Schedule:

Between April 16–May 15: \$200 will be refunded if you withdraw

Between May 16–June 18: \$100 will be refunded if you withdraw

After June 18: No refunds

Registrations will be accepted subject to space available in the course. Scholarships may be available if the fee would be a hardship on your family. Contact Dr. Bittner (or a Sequoia High School counselor if you are a Sequoia student) for details.

Sequoia High School has offered to provide textbooks on loan for this class, subject to availability. If the textbooks are not available, you may need to borrow or buy a textbook, but every effort will be made to obtain the textbooks on loan. If you are not a Sequoia student, you will be required to pay a refundable book deposit of \$50. This deposit will be fully refunded when your borrowed book is returned in good condition.
